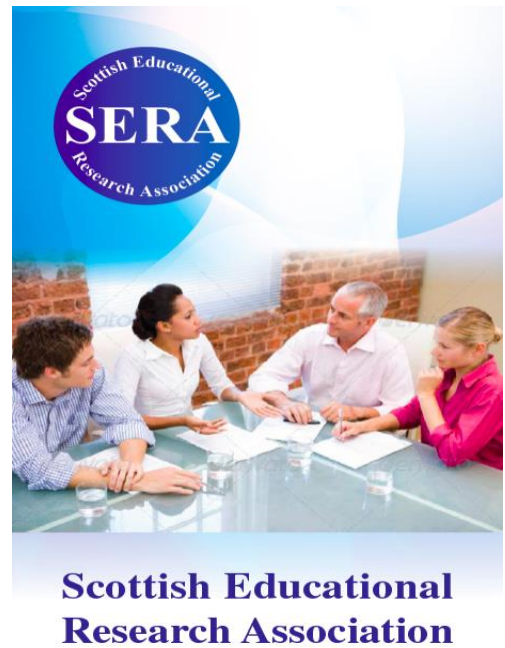


# A Conversation with Professor Megan Crawford
